### **ENVIRONMENTAL STUDIES 130, "ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES: SOCIAL SCIENCES" RAYMOND CLEMENCON**

Case studies include air pollution and human health, global climate change, nature and biodiversity conservation, use of genetically modified organisms, and management of marine resources.
