Qualifications:

- Transfer Orientation Leaders must be undergraduate students who will have completed at least 32 units at UCSD units by the end of Spring Quarter, 2012.
- Must be available to attend:
 - a) Weekly 1.5 hour training sessions throughout Spring Quarter (day and time of trainings TBD)
 - b) Transfer Admit Day on Saturday, May 12 from 9am – 1pm
 - c) Spring Leadership Retreat on Sunday, May 20th, 2012 from 8:30am – 5:30pm
 - d) Intensive Training and Transfer Orientation Sessions August 8 -12, 2012 from 7am – 5pm each day*
***Please note this is during Summer Session II; you will not be able to attend classes during this time**
 - e) Attendance at Muir College's Fall Transfer Orientation on September 18, 2012 is requested but not required.
