ERC GE requirements prepare students for most pre-law programs.

Some recommended pre-law courses are:

- Strong writing competence & critical analysis skills (MMW)
- Math or Logic (Quantitative Formal Skills)
- Public Speaking/Intro to Acting (Fine Arts group B)



Remember...

- There is no required or preferred undergraduate major for students who wish to become lawyers.
- Students interested in law should major in a field which engages them and in which they can perform well.
- There is a strong emphasis placed on applicants GPA.
- Applicants score on the Law School Admission Test (LSAT) is the other most important criteria used by law schools.
- Career Services Professional & Grad School program hosts a law school fair each fall.
- UCSD offers the "Law & Society" Minor which offers students the opportunity to examine issues related to law.
