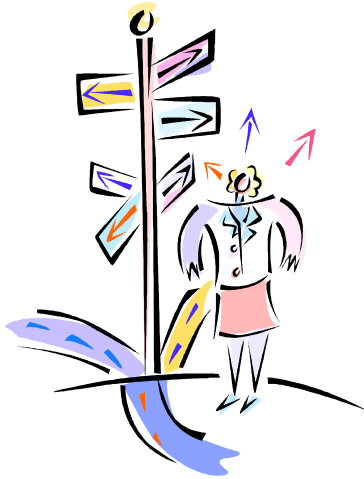


HAVING TROUBLE CHOOSING A MAJOR?

HERE ARE SOME TIPS!



How to get started exploring majors:

- Choose a few departments that interest you.
 - Use these resources: Department Coordinators, Undergraduate Faculty Advisors, Department Brochures/Newsletters/Web sites, UCSD catalog and UCSD Web site.
 - Take a lower division course in a major of interest.

- Talk with a faculty member in the department. Ask: What sorts of things do student study in this major? What type of research do they do?
 - Ask other students about their experiences in classes.
 - Go to the bookstore and look at the textbooks assigned for courses in the major.
 - Use Career Services and their self-assessments for more information about your interests, etc.
 - Use alumni contacts through Career Services to see what types of jobs students are doing with different majors.
 - Talk to an ERC Academic Counselor – that’s what we’re here for!
 - Attend our annual Undeclared Majors Workshop. Ask the ERC Advising front desk for more details.
